LKTYP Nominated for Five Dora Awards!

The **Toronto Alliance for the Performing Arts** announced yesterday that **Lorraine Kimsa Theatre for Young People (LKTYP)** has been nominated for five **Dora Mavor Moore Awards** for the 2009/10 season – three in the General Theatre Division and two in the Theatre for Young Audiences Division.

Nomination highlights include a nod to **Leslie Arden** for Outstanding New Musical/Opera (*The Princess & the Handmaiden*), to **Paul Sun-Hyung Lee** for Outstanding Performance by a Male in a Principal Role (*The Monster Under the Bed*), and to **Romeo Candido** for Outstanding Original Sound Design/Composition (*The Monster Under the Bed*), all in the General Theatre Division.

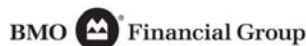
