LKTYP Welcomes Montreal's Théâtre Tout à Trac and their Clever Adaptation of *Alice in Wonderland*

Lorraine Kimsa Theatre for Young People (LKTYP) is thrilled to welcome Montreal's **Théâtre Tout à Trac** and their clever adaptation of **Lewis Carroll's *Alice in Wonderland***. This beautiful take on the beloved children's classic will be presented on the Mainstage from March 1 to 19, 2011, with added performances during March Break.

Alice is once again day dreaming rather than doing homework when a book-devouring rabbit appears out of nowhere. Alice chases him down his rabbit hole and suddenly finds herself in Wonderland – a nonsensical universe populated by the Queen of Hearts, Humpty Dumpty, the Cheshire Cat, the Mad Hatter and a host of peculiar residents. Watch this award-winning adaptation of the classic story as the set and props morph from simple objects into something magical and puppetry and mask are ingeniously integrated into the action. 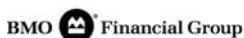
