

***i think i can* and *Seussical* Lead the Way as
LKTYP wins FOUR Dora Awards!**

TORONTO, ON (Tuesday, June 26, 2007) – The 28th annual **Dora Mavor Moore Awards**, celebrating excellence in Toronto Theatre, were presented at the Winter Garden Theatre on Monday evening with Lorraine Kimsa Theatre for Young People (LKTYP) receiving four awards.

In the General Theatre Division, LKTYP's world premiere of *i think i can*, created by **Florence Gibson** and **Shawn Byfield**, won for Outstanding New Musical. *Seussical* was also honoured with nods for **Allen MacInnis** (Outstanding Direction of a Musical), and **Corrine Koslo** (Outstanding Performance by a Female in a Principal Role - Musical).

Comet in Moominland, produced by **Manitoba Theatre for Young People** and presented by LKTYP, took the prize for Outstanding Production in the Theatre for Young Audiences Division.

Lorraine Kimsa Theatre for Young People received sixteen Dora Award nominations this year and extends congratulations to all the nominees along with a heartfelt thank you to all the talented artists, technicians, sponsors, patrons, volunteers and staff for their contributions to a wonderfully successful season!

About The Dora Mavor Moore Awards: The Dora Mavor Moore Awards, presented by the Toronto Alliance for the Performing Arts, honour the creators of over 200 theatre, dance and opera productions annually in five major categories: General Theatre, Independent Theatre, Dance, Opera, and Theatre for Young Audiences. Each winner receives a bronze statue cast from an original by sculptor John Romano. The Doras are named for Dora Mavor Moore, a well-loved teacher and director who helped establish Canadian professional theatre in the 1930s and 1940s.
